RE: CalVoter/VoteCal: System of Record

As you know, the SOS has been targeting June 2016 to declare VoteCal as the system of record for voter registration in California. With your help, the VoteCal project team has been conducting several activities to prepare VoteCal to be the State's system of record. These include the mock election, on-going performance testing, verifying VoteCal's functionality, and analyzing and monitoring the data in VoteCal.

To ensure that VoteCal functions as designed, the SOS has decided to continue these activities beyond the original June 2016 target timeframe for declaring VoteCal to be the State's system of record. The SOS now expects to declare VoteCal as the system of record in late August 2016. CalVoter will continue to be the current system of record for voter registration in California.

Counties will utilize VoteCal functionality for voter registration and list maintenance activities with the exception of DMV Change of Address.

Once the Secretary of State certifies that the state has a statewide voter registration database that complies with the requirements of the federal Help America Vote Act of 2002, (e.g. certified VoteCal as the system of record) additional guidance will be provided.

The table below lists and describes activities that counties will continue to perform for voter registration activities as a result of CalVoter being maintained as the system of record and the counties being live on VoteCal.
