Lance H. Olson, Thomas A. Willis, and Dario J. Frommer, the proponents of TAX EXTENSION TO FUND EDUCATION AND HEALTHCARE. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. (#1773), have filed more than 643,948 valid signatures with the counties.

Therefore, pursuant to Elections Code section 9033, the initiative measure is eligible for the November 8, 2016, General Election ballot and all further signature verification can be terminated.

On June 30, 2016, the Secretary of State will certify the initiative as qualified for the November 8, 2016, General Election ballot, unless withdrawn by the proponent(s) prior to certification pursuant to Elections Code section 9604(b).
