Dustin Corcoran, Laphonza Butler, Olivia J. Diaz-Lapham, and Tom Steyer, the proponents of CIGARETTE TAX TO FUND HEALTHCARE, TOBACCO USE PREVENTION, RESEARCH, AND LAW ENFORCEMENT. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AND STATUTE. (#1741), have filed more than 643,948 valid signatures with the counties.

Therefore, pursuant to Elections Code section 9033, the initiative measure is eligible for the November 8, 2016, General Election ballot and all further signature verification can be terminated.

On June 30, 2016, the Secretary of State will certify the initiative as qualified for the November 8, 2016, General Election ballot, unless withdrawn by the proponent(s) prior to certification pursuant to Elections Code section 9604(b).
