RE: BALLOT TINT AND WATERMARK FOR NOVEMBER 6, 2007,
UDEL ELECTION

Pursuant to Elections Code § 13002 and the California Code of Regulations, Title 2 § 20211, the Secretary of State's office has selected a design/watermark and color for use in the November 6, 2007, Uniform District Election Law elections (UDELs).

The ballot design/watermark for the November 6, 2007, UDELs is the CA Map Outline. The color is White.

This design/watermark and color selection is only to be used in the November 6, 2007, UDEL elections.

NOTE: Ink formulas equivalent to PMS formulas may be used to match color samples.

Please note that for "color-on-color" combinations, the tint value for the background should produce a light tint. The design should be clearly visible and distinct from the background. The screen percentages for the design should be such that the outline is darker than the background and the interior area of the design is lighter than the background.
