





RE: Voter Registration: Court-Ordered Voter Registration

The Secretary of State's Elections Division is developing a page on our website which would serve as a central location for California's voters to reference established procedures to assist them with the process of "Court-Ordered Voter Registration."

Elections Code sections 2100 and 2142 permit a qualified elector, including those who claim to have registered to vote through the Department of Motor Vehicles or any public agency designated as a voter registration agency described in the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. Sec. 1973gg), to seek an order from the superior court to compel his or her registration when the county elections official refuses to register them.
