



RE: Administrative: Overseas Voters, Webinar on Federal Pilot Program

This is a time-sensitive announcement.

On Wednesday, April 21, 2010, at 8:30 a.m. Pacific Daylight Time, the Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP) will host a web-based seminar (referred to as a webinar) on a pilot program that may provide states with an additional way to comply with the Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment (MOVE) Act.

States must comply with the MOVE Act by the November 2010 General Election. Counties received CC/ROV #10042 on January 29, 2010, describing MOVE Act provisions and how California already complies with those provisions.

The FVAP is proposing a pilot program that would match states and counties with vendors that would provide an Electronic Voting Support Wizard (Wizard) that would allow voters to download an individual, fillable PDF ballot, print it, sign it and mail it back to your office. The program is still being developed and the FVAP is seeking state and county input on how to design the program by learning about state and county requirements.
