Per Code Section 8022, if nomination documents for an incumbent State Senator, Assemblymember, State Constitutional Officer, Insurance Commissioner, Member of the United States House of Representatives, or United States Senator are not delivered by 5 p.m. on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the statewide direct primary election, any person other than the person who was the incumbent on the 88<sup>th</sup> day shall have until 5 p.m. on the 83<sup>rd</sup> day before the election to file nomination documents for the elective office.

The deadline for these offices is extended to **Wednesday, March 17, 2010**. All nomination documents are to be forwarded by the county elections official to the Secretary of State's office by March 22, 2010
