





RE: Recount Regulations: County Security Measures

This is a reminder that California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Division 7, section 20817, which took effect in December 2009, requires counties to create and submit to the Secretary of State written security measures to ensure the integrity of recount proceedings. This is a one-time requirement; there is no requirement to re-submit the recount security measures for each election. Only if changes are subsequently made will it be necessary to submit the revised document to the Secretary of State.

If you have not submitted your county's recount security measures to the Secretary of State, please do so as soon as possible but no later than Monday, November 15, 2010.

Counties conducting the special primary election for Senate District 1 must submit the recount security measures no later than Friday, November 5, 2010.

If your county has submitted this document to the Secretary of State's Office as part of a package of documents, please submit the recount security measures as a separate document.
