RE Presidential Primary Election: Nomination Period Filing Extension

Pursuant to Elections Code section 8022, if nomination documents for an incumbent Member of Congress, State Senator, or Assemblymember, are not delivered by 5:00 p.m. on the 88th day before the primary election, any person other than the person who was the incumbent on the 88th day shall have until 5:00 p.m. on the 83rd day before the election to file nomination documents for the elective office.

Based on the nomination documents submitted to the Secretary of State by the county elections officials as of 11:00 p.m. on Friday, March 9, 2012, attached is the list of U.S. Congress, State Senate (odd-numbered districts), and State Assembly offices where the filing deadline is extended to **Wednesday, March 14, 2012**. All nomination documents are to be forwarded by the county elections official to the Secretary of State's office by March 19, 2012.
