RE: Regulations: Electronic Poll Book – Second Notice of Modifications

The Electronic Poll Book regulations are required by Elections Code section 2550(c). The regulations were drafted for purposes of establishing clear and concise requirements for certification of electronic poll book systems.

Pursuant to the requirements of subdivision (c) of Section 11346.8 of the Government Code and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Secretary of State is providing notice of changes to the text of the proposed regulations originally published on October 20, 2017, and again on January 19, 2018.

Any interested person, or their authorized representative, may submit written comments pertaining to the changes in the text of the proposed regulations. The Secretary of State will accept written comments on the changes from April 16, 2018, to May 1, 2018. The written comment period closes at 5:00 p.m. on May 1, 2018. The Secretary of State will consider only comments received at the Secretary of State's office by that time.
