Please provide the number of state voter information guides your county will need for the upcoming June 5, 2018, Statewide Direct Primary Election and any special shipping instructions you may have on the attached State Voter Information Guide Order Form and return it to me by <u>Wednesday, February 14, 2018.</u>

If your county will need state voter information guides delivered to different locations, please specify the special shipping instructions pertinent to each location and indicate whether you would like the guides shipped on cartons, pallets, cartons on pallets, or any combination of the three.

As you know, the Secretary of State will mail directly to voters registered up to E-60, and for the first time, those voters registered between April 7, 2018 (E-59) and May 7, 2018 (E-29).

Counties are still responsible for mailing state voter information guides to all of their overseas, out-of-state, and confidential voters.

In addition to the change in mailing responsibilities; due to the passage of AB 606 (Chapter 656, Statutes of 2017) the text of proposed laws will no longer be printed in the main VIG. However, copies of the text of proposed laws will be available online and in print by request. Accordingly, you will notice a new section of the order form that allows counties to request quantities of the separate text of proposed laws to be provided to voters upon request.

Once the information has been compiled, we will send you a copy of your completed order and shipping instructions, and you will have an opportunity to make any changes at that time.
