RE: Primary Election: Late Ballot Measure

On January 31, 2018, the Governor signed urgency legislation placing an additional measure on the June 5, 2018, Statewide Direct Primary Election ballot. The new measure has been numbered Proposition 72 and is listed below (in bold). The proposition numbers assigned in [CCROV #18022](#) have not changed and are listed below for reference.

- Proposition 68 California Drought, Water, Parks, Climate, Coastal Protection, and Outdoor Access For All Act of 2018. (SB 5, Chapter 852, Statutes of 2017)
- Proposition 69 Motor vehicle fees and taxes: restriction on expenditures: appropriations limit. (ACA 5, Resolution Chapter 30, Statutes of 2017)
- Proposition 70 Greenhouse Gas Reduction Reserve Fund. (ACA 1, Resolution Chapter 105, Statutes of 2017)
- Proposition 71 Ballot measures: effective date. (ACA 17, Resolution Chapter 190, Statutes of 2017)
- Proposition 72 Property tax: new construction exclusion: rain water capture system. (SCA 9, Resolution Chapter 1, Statutes of 2018)**

The English ballot labels and titles and summaries for the propositions will be made available when the state Voter Information Guide goes on Public Display on February 20, 2018, and will be subject to court-ordered changes through March 12, 2018. After March 12, 2018, the final ballot labels and titles and summaries will be provided to you.
