


### Historical Registration: 29-day Close

 ■ Decline to State 14.7%


## February 4, 2002 Report of Registration

### TRENDS:

Since the February 7, 2000 Report of Registration (29-day close):

- the percentage of total registration in the state has increased from 68.95% to 70.87%;
- registration in the qualified political parties has declined from 85.20% to 84.44%;
- registration in the Democratic party has declined from 45.69% to 45.09%;
- registration in the Republican party has declined from 35.14% to 35.01%;
- the number of voters who have declined to state has increased from 13.89% to 14.69%; and
- since 6/19/95 (when NVRA began), 9,591,827 people have registered or reregistered in conjunction with "Motor Voter"
