

PREFACE

This Supplement to the Statement of Vote, produced pursuant to Elections Code section 15502, contains the official vote count results by districts and counties on the recall question, for the 135 partisan candidates for Governor, and two ballot measures that appeared on California's October 7, 2003 statewide special election ballot.

The first report for each contest presents a summary of the vote totals by county. The second contains the totals by political subdivision within each county, followed by the results for each Congressional, State Senate, State Assembly, and Board of Equalization district. The district results indicate the vote cast district wide and within each county that comprises the district.

Due to budgetary constraints, this Supplement to the Statement of Vote will not be printed in book form. The data will be available online at the Secretary of State website, www.ss.ca.gov.
