The polling place notice shall state whether the polling place is accessible to the physically handicapped.	§ 13303
10/05/09	(E-29)	4	PRECINCT BOARD MEMBERS AND POLLING PLACES The last day for the county elections official to appoint the members of the several precinct boards and designate the polling places.	§ 12286

12/12/09	(E+39)	18 CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION The last day for the Secretary of State to determine votes cast for Assembly and to certify the person having the highest number of votes for that office as duly elected. It is the intention of the Secretary of State to issue a certificate immediately after receipt of the results of the official canvass.	§§ 15501, 15504
