Counties should continue to submit regular Registrant Load/Update files according to California Administrative Code Title 2, Division 7, Chapter 2, Section 20108.40 until such time that VoteCal is declared the system of record for voter registration. Counties whose voter registration system will not support the UPDATE file type may submit full LOAD files.
