RE: General Election: Proposition 9

As you know, Proposition 9 was removed from the November 6, 2018, General Election ballot by order of the California Supreme Court on July 18, 2018.

In order to avoid confusion to voters, we recommend that counties indicate on their ballot that it has been removed. The following language is recommended to be placed on the ballot in between Propositions 8 and 10:

“Proposition 9 was removed from the ballot by order of the California Supreme Court.”

If it is not possible to reference it on the ballot, we recommend that you provide a statement about its removal from the ballot in your county voter information guide.

Translations of the recommended statement will be provided as well.
