RE: California Gubernatorial Recall Election: Early Ballot Retrieval Ballot

Collection and Chain of Custody Procedures

As you may be aware, Section 20143(a) of the California Code of Regulations requires counties retrieving ballots prior to the closing of the polls pursuant to Elections Code section 14422, to develop early ballot retrieval collection and chain of custody procedures.

Section 20143(b) of the California Code of Regulations further requires county elections officials to provide a copy of those early ballot retrieval collection and chain of custody procedures to the Secretary of State's office by the 30th day before an election in which ballots will be retrieved prior to the closing of the polls.
