RE: Voter Education and Outreach: Voter Bill of Rights Posters

Elections Code section 14105.3 requires the Secretary of State to print and distribute Voter Bill of Rights posters to county elections officials. These posters must be posted inside and outside each polling place or vote center in every language required in your county.

Our office has updated the language of the Voter Bill of Rights to reflect recent statutory changes due to the passage of Proposition 17. We are asking that counties use the updated Voter Bill of Rights to ensure the current law is posted.

While we are in the process of making printed versions available, the updated Voter Bill of Rights posters are available to print on our website at <https://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/voter-bill-rights>, for immediate use. An additional CC/ROV will be issued once printed versions are available for distribution.
