RE: Regulations: Notices Regarding Prohibition of Electioneering and

Corruption of the Voting Process

The Secretary of State is proposing to readopt the emergency regulations it adopted on February 22, 2022, related to notice requirements regarding the prohibition of electioneering and activity that relates to the corruption of the voting process.

The purpose of the readoption is to keep the emergency regulations in effect during the time of the regular rulemaking process to make the emergency regulations permanent.

## **Notice period:**

This notice period will run from August 11, 2022, through August 19, 2022. At the end of the notice period, the Secretary of State will submit the required documents to the Office of Administrative Law for the readoption of these emergency regulations.
