RE: Higher Education Partnership Joint Resolution Signing

On Wednesday, June 29, 2022, from 2:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. the California Secretary of State and the University of California (UC) are holding a press event announcing the signing of a joint resolution affirming a partnership to increase access to voting for students and the general public on UC campuses state-wide. Goals include:

- Encouraging greater partnerships between local counties and UC campuses

- Increasing access to trusted voting locations state-wide
