RE: Primary Election: SB35 Notice Posters

Pursuant to the Secretary of State's adoption of emergency regulations as required by Senate Bill 35 (SB 35, Chapter 385 of the Statutes of 2021), county elections officials are required to post notices regarding prohibition of electioneering and corruption of the voting process on their websites, and conspicuously at all buildings that contain a polling place (including an election official's office or a satellite location) and any outdoor site (including a curbside voting area and a vote-by-mail ballot drop box) at which a voter may cast or drop off a ballot.

To assist counties with these posting requirements, the Secretary of State has created a combined poster that is available for counties to order. The 11" x 17" poster contains both SB35 notices and is available in English, Spanish, Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Tagalog, Thai, and Vietnamese.
