RE: General Election: ACTION REQUIRED -- Drop-Box Ballot Collection
and Chain of Custody Procedures

As you may be aware, Elections Code section 3025.5 requires all counties to provide at least one drop box for vote-by-mail ballots. In addition, Section 20137(c) of the California Code of Regulations requires counties using vote-by-mail drop boxes to develop ballot retrieval collection and chain of custody procedures. These chain of custody procedures must be submitted to the Secretary of State's office not later than E-30 -- October 9, 2022.

Please submit your county's drop box collection and chain of custody procedures for the November 8, 2022, General Election. Please provide all responses by, **Friday, October 7, 2022**, to survey@sos.ca.gov.
