RE: Regulations: Experimental Use of a Voting System in a Pilot Program –
Notice of Modifications

The Experimental Use of a Voting System in a Pilot Program regulations are required by Elections Code section 19209(g). The regulations were drafted for purposes of establishing clear and concise requirements for the experimental use of a voting system in a pilot program.

Pursuant to the requirements of subdivision (c) of Section 11346.8 of the Government Code and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Secretary of State is providing notice of changes to the text of the proposed regulations originally published on August 5, 2022.

Any interested person, or their authorized representative, may submit written comments pertaining to the changes in the text of the proposed regulations. The Secretary of State will accept written comments on the changes from January 4, 2023, to January 20, 2023. The written comment period closes at 5:00 p.m. on January 20, 2023. The Secretary of State will consider only comments received at the Secretary of State's office by that time.
