- RE: Presidential Primary: Drop-Box Ballot Collection and Chain of Custody Procedures - ACTION REQUIRED

As you may be aware, Elections Code section 3025.5 requires all counties to provide at least one drop box for vote-by-mail ballots. In addition, Section 20137(c) of the California Code of Regulations requires counties using vote-by-mail drop boxes to develop ballot retrieval collection and chain of custody procedures. These chain of custody procedures must be submitted to the Secretary of State's office not later than E-30 -- February 4, 2024.

Please submit your county's drop box collection and chain of custody procedures for the March 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election. Please provide all responses by, **Friday**, **February 2, 2024**, to <u>survey@sos.ca.gov</u>.
