RE: General Election: Early Ballot Retrieval Ballot Collection and Chain of

Custody Procedures - ACTION REQUIRED

Before each election, counties may choose to retrieve ballots prior to the closing of the polls. If ballots are to be retrieved in this manner, the county must develop early ballot retrieval collection and chain of custody procedures. These chain of custody procedures must be submitted to the Secretary of State's office not later than E-30 – October 6, 2024. (Elections Code section 14422 and California Code of Regulations sections 20143(a) and (b)).

If you are conducting early ballot retrieval, please also submit your county's chain of custody procedures for the November 5, 2024, General Election.
