RE: General Election: Election Observer Panel Plans (EOPPs)-

Submission No Longer Required

The Secretary of State previously required county election officials to submit Election Observer Panel Plans (EOPPs) for statewide elections. However, the newly enacted Title 2, Division 7, Chapter 8.2 of the California Code of Regulations, governing Election Observations Rights and Responsibilities, establishes detailed uniform requirements and procedures for elections officials and public observers. Additionally, these regulations mandate that elections official publish their observation rules and procedures both in person and on their website. Consequently, the Secretary of State has determined that the submission of EOPPs from the county elections officials is redundant and no longer necessary.
