RE: Statewide Special Election: Voter Information Guide (VIG) Mailing

The Secretary of State (SOS) will be processing Voter Information Guide (VIG) mailing labels of registered voters with a valid California mailing address as of E-60 (September 5, 2025) as well as for voters registered between E-59 and E-29 (September 6 – October 6, 2025). The procedure for processing these mailing labels is as follows:

60-Day Mailing

- □ **Election Setup:** Verify the November 4, 2025, Statewide Special Election is set up locally in the Election Management System (EMS) so that VoteCal will have access to the associated precinct/district mapping.
- Precinct Setup: Verify that all active precincts are assigned to the November 4, 2025, Statewide Special Election.
- Synchronization Check: Complete a synchronization (sync) check and resolve any differences between August 16, 2025 (E-80), and the time readiness is indicated. A successful sync check completed for the 60-day Report of Registration will satisfy this requirement.
- Enter Registrations: Enter all online and paper registrations into the county EMS with a registration date up to and including the 60-Day Close (September 5, 2025) by September 15, 2025 (E-50).

Complete Readiness Form: Complete the attached "60-Day Close Voter Information Guide (VIG) Readiness Form" and e-mail it to votecalhelp@sos.ca.gov no later than September 15, 2025 (E-50).

29-Day Mailing

- □ Enter Registrations: Enter all online and paper registrations with a registration date of September 6, 2025 (E-59) to October 6, 2025 (E-29) into the county EMS.
- PLEASE NOTE: The Secretary of State (SOS) will mail statewide VIGs directly to all non-military voters with domestic mailing addresses (including U.S. territories).

Each county will again be responsible for mailing VIGs to:

- Registrants with an out-of-country mailing address.
- Qualified confidential voters.
- Registrants with registrations that did not get uploaded to VoteCal at the time the SOS extracted the mailing file.
- Registrants with registrations that did not pass the mailing standardization process.
- □ Registrants with a registration date after October 6, 2025 (E-29) by request only.

After the 60-Day Close VIG mailing extract process has been completed in mid-September, an email will be sent out with specific instructions on how counties are to handle the mailings of VIGs to these addresses. Instructions will also be sent shortly after the 29-Day VIG mailing extract process has been completed.
