RE: VoteCal: Voting Rights Disqualifications and Restorations Web-based

Training

Elections Code section 2214 requires that each county elections official and county court executive officer complete a yearly training on voting rights disqualifications and restorations and their role in the process.

In January 2024, the Secretary of State (SOS) published three PowerPoint modules that were available for self-paced training accessible through the <u>SOS website</u>.

To enhance the training experience, an interactive ADA accessible eLearning course is now available on CalHR's Learning Management System, <u>CalLearns</u>. The training is a free, self-paced interactive course and attendees will no longer have to report completion as CalLearns will automatically track attendance. The name of the course is "Voter Registration Restorations and Cancellations Training."

County elections officials will need to create an account on <u>CalLearns</u> (if an account does not exist already) and register for the annual course. Please see the attached instructions for creating and logging into a CalLearns account.

The PowerPoint modules currently located on the <u>SOS website</u> will remain as a reference document, but credit for completing the course will only be applied if the training is completed through CalLearns.

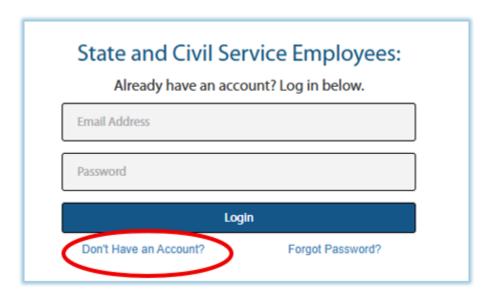
