RE: Primary Election: Drop-Box Ballot Collection and Chain of Custody
Procedures – ACTION REQUIRED

As you may be aware, Elections Code section 3025.5 requires all counties to provide at least one drop box for vote-by-mail ballots. In addition, Section 20137(c) of the California Code of Regulations requires counties using vote-by-mail drop boxes to develop ballot retrieval collection and chain of custody procedures. These chain of custody procedures must be submitted to the Secretary of State's office.

Please submit your county's drop box collection and chain of custody procedures for the June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election. Please provide all responses by Friday, **May 1, 2026**, to survey@sos.ca.gov.
