Elections Code section 21000 requires that for every election, county elections officials provide "any information and statistics that may be necessary for use in reapportionment." The Legislature has designated the Statewide Database as the entity to receive and manage this information.

Please provide documentation for all files sent in electronic form, including format sheets with a list of fields and their contents where applicable.

Checklist of data to submit to Statewide Database by August 4, 2026

- ❑ **Registration Precinct and Sub-Precinct Maps:** Please provide GIS shape and street files or a complete set of paper maps. If you provide paper maps, please send a precinct-to-map page guide. Please include the same precinct names as are used to report voter registration.
- ❑ **List of precincts changed between the 2026 Primary Election and the 2026 General Election.** For each precinct changed, identify the reason for the change (e.g., new, abolished, annexation, etc.), the number of voters affected, and the map page for the precinct.

Checklist of data to submit to Statewide Database by December 3, 2026

- ❑ **Statement of Vote (SOV) / By-Precinct Report of Voting Results in electronic form.** Please provide in **text file (tab or csv delimited)** or **excel (.xls/.xlsx) format. PDFs will not suffice.** The report should:
 - Include total registration and total votes cast by vote-by-mail and poll precincts;
 - Include each precinct's results broken down by vote-by-mail and poll ballots cast for each proposition and candidate;
 - Include all precinct totals. Please generate this report with the privacy option turned off.

Please note that elections officials are required to report the SOV/By-Precinct Report of Voting results in an electronic form. Please provide data in a machine readable format. A scanned copy of a hard copy will not suffice.

- ❑ **Consolidation list (voting precinct to registration precinct) in electronic form. Please include any zero voter registration precincts and their associated voting precincts.**
- ❑ **Party total registration broken down by precinct.**
- ❑ **Final list of precincts within districts and cities in electronic form.**
- ❑ **Master street index (address-to-precinct-assignment file) in electronic form only.** A scanned copy of a hard copy will not suffice.
- ❑ **Precinct listing that identifies vote-by-mail precinct by regular precinct and ballot type.** If consolidations are used, please provide this list by voting precinct.
