RE: Primary Election: Ballot Tint and Watermark
Assignment

Pursuant to Elections Code section 13002 and the California Code of Regulations, Title 2, sections 20215, 20218, and 20280, the Secretary of State's office has selected a design and color combination for use in the June 2, 2026, Primary Election.

The watermark for the June 2, 2026, Primary Election is the **CA Capitol**. The tint for the background and watermark is **PMS 271 U "Purple"** (RGB 159, 158, 211 /CMYK 25, 25, 0, 17). For all county administered local elections previously scheduled for June 2, 2026, which will be consolidated with the June 2, 2026, Primary Election, the above tint and watermark assignment shall be used.

The watermark and tint must appear on the ballot itself, not only on the stub.

Please note that for "color-on-color" combinations, the tint value for the background should produce a light tint. The watermark should be clearly visible and distinct from the background. The screen percentages for the watermark should be such that the outline is darker than the background and the interior area of the watermark is lighter than the background.

As a reminder, any jurisdiction wishing to purchase ballot cards from a ballot printer shall request in writing a ballot release from the Secretary of State per the California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Division 7, Chapter 4, Article 4, sections [20233](#) and [20234](#). To request a ballot release number, email the Secretary of State's office at BallotRelease@sos.ca.gov. Attached below is the Ballot Release Form for use when requesting a ballot release number.

Instructions:

A Secretary of State Request for Ballot Card Release form must be completed for all ballot release number requests. Submissions using other forms may be rejected, which may result in a delay of the processing time.

- Requests will be accepted by mail to OVSTA, Executive Office– 6th Floor, 1500 11th Street, Sacramento CA 95814, or by e-mail to BallotRelease@sos.ca.gov.
- Once the submitted information is verified, a ballot release number will be assigned, the release number will be added to the top of the form and returned via email to both the Requestor and Vendor.
- A Ballot Card Accounting Record shall be prepared and submitted to the Secretary of State pursuant to California Code of Regulations Section 20235.
- A Warehouse Inventory Control Record shall be prepared and submitted to the Secretary of State pursuant to California Code of Regulations Section 20236.
- A Ballot Scrap and Destruction Report shall be prepared and submitted to the Secretary of State pursuant to California Code of Regulations Section 20238.
