RE: Primary Election: Final Collection of Ballots from Drop Boxes - Action
Required

As you are aware, upon the closing of the polls on Election Day, all drop boxes shall be locked and covered or otherwise made unavailable at 8:00 p.m. to ensure that no ballots are dropped off after the polls have closed.

The Secretary of State's Office strongly encourages county elections officials to retrieve as many ballots as practicable from staffed and unstaffed drop boxes before 11:59 p.m. on Election Day. If that is not feasible, ballots shall be retrieved from those drop boxes by 8:00 p.m. on the day after the election. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 20136(f).)

California Code of Regulations section 20136(f)(2) requires that all county elections officials certify to the Secretary of State immediately upon retrieving ballots from all staffed and unstaffed drop boxes that all ballots have been retrieved from all staffed and unstaffed drop boxes.

Additionally, county elections officials shall provide written notification to the Secretary of State in the event a county is aware that they are or may not be able to retrieve all ballots by 8:00 p.m. on the day after Election Day. The written notification shall be made immediately upon the determination that not all ballots will be retrieved prior to 8:00 p.m. on the day after Election Day. When all ballots have been retrieved from all staffed and unstaffed drop boxes, the elections official shall provide the required certification.
