As a result of the Consent Decree entered into by the Secretary of State (SOS) and the United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), all of California's 58 counties must respond to three surveys, which will be issued by the SOS starting on Wednesday, September 10, 2014. These surveys address absentee ballots transmitted to voters covered under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA), of which the Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment (MOVE) Act is a part.

SOS would like to request that each county provide a point of contact for the three UOCAVA/MOVE Act surveys. Given the tight turnaround deadlines, please make sure this person is someone who can be easily reached the day the survey is due in case additional information is needed.
