The Secretary of State's office has compiled the results of the survey regarding how much counties plan to charge for legislative and congressional candidate statements and the additional foreign languages in which the statements may be printed.

The costs reflected in the candidate statement survey are only estimates. Candidates should be advised to contact the specific county elections office for the exact costs.

This report identifies the legislative candidates who have accepted the campaign expenditure limits under Proposition 34 and who are allowed to purchase a candidate statement in the appropriate county sample ballot/voter information guide for the upcoming election.

The final report will be issued in conjunction with the Certified List of Candidates on March 27, 2014 (E-68). A copy of the final report will be mailed to your county for your records.
