Pursuant to Elections Code section 8022, if nomination documents for an incumbent United States Senator, Member of Congress, State Senator, or Assemblymember are not delivered by 5:00 p.m. on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the primary election, any person, other than the incumbent, has until 5:00 p.m. on the 83<sup>rd</sup> day before the election to file nomination documents for that office.

Based on the nomination documents submitted to the Secretary of State by the county elections officials as of 7:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2016, attached is the list of the United States Senator, Member of Congress, State Senate (odd-numbered districts), and State Assembly offices where the filing deadline is extended to **Wednesday, March 16, 2016**.

All nomination documents are to be forwarded by the county elections official to the Secretary of State, Elections Division, by Monday, March 21, 2016.
