RE: Presidential Primary: Ballot Tint and Watermark

Pursuant to Elections Code section 13002 and California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 20213, the Secretary of State's office has selected a design and color combinations for use in the June 7, 2016, Presidential Primary Election. **The design for this election is the California State Seal.** The color combinations are listed below.

The design and tint must appear on the ballot itself, not only on the ballot stub.

For color-on-color combinations, the tint value for the background should produce a light tint. The design should be clearly visible and distinct from the background. The screen percentages for the design should be such that the outline is darker than the background and the interior area of the design is lighter than the background.
