- RE: VoteCal: Synchronization Checks

To ensure synchronization (sync) between VoteCal and the county's Election Management System (EMS), county elections officials should, at a minimum, complete a sync check and take appropriate actions to resolve the data differences:

- Every six (6) months, unless a sync check has been completed for a Report of Registration (ROR) within that six (6) month period; and
- No more than thirty (30) days prior to the creation of a ROR or an Official List for an election.

VoteCal provides a sync check service in order to identify data differences between the VoteCal statewide voter registration system and the county's EMS. A sync check can be requested by a county or the Secretary of State. When a sync check is generated, VoteCal compares (1) voter registration data; (2) voter participation history; (3) dates of creation and modification of affidavit, affidavit signature, and correspondence images; (4) precinct data; and (5) political district data. VoteCal provides a list of data differences to the appropriate county for resolution.
