RE: Regulations: Conditional Voter Registration

The Secretary of State has submitted proposed regulations relating to Conditional Voter Registration to the Office of Administrative Law. These regulations establish the procedures for processing Conditional Voter Registrations and, if the registration is accepted, the subsequent processing of the CVR provisional ballots.

The 45-day written public comment period begins today, November 17, and goes through January 2, 2018. No hearing date has been scheduled; however, any interested person, or their authorized representative, can submit a written request for a public hearing no later than Monday, December 18, 2017.

Following the public hearing, if one is requested, or following the close of the written comment period if no public hearing is requested, the Secretary of State, upon its own motion or at the instance of any interested party, may thereafter adopt the proposals or may modify such proposals if such modifications are sufficiently related to the original text. With the exception of technical or grammatical changes, the full text of any modified proposal will be available from our office for 15 days prior to its adoption and will be mailed to those persons who submit written or oral testimony related to this proposal or who have requested notification of any changes to the proposal.
