RE: Voting Systems: OVSTA Monthly Update – April 2018

Each month, the Office of Voting Systems Technology Assessment (OVSTA) provides an update on Election Assistance Commission (EAC) and Secretary of State (SOS) activities related to voting technology.

Each update provides information on:

- Voting technology related events that may be of interest.
- Administrative approvals and denials since the prior month's update.
- Administrative approval requests since the prior month's update.
- Voting technology testing and approval at the SOS office.
- Voting system testing and certification at the EAC.
- Defect, failure, and fault reports issued since the prior month's update.
- Ballot printing certification requests since the prior month's update.

Recent and Upcoming Events

A public hearing has been scheduled for April 27, 2018, at the California Secretary of State Building, 1500 11th Street, Sacramento, in the Auditorium at 9 a.m., for Dominion Voting Systems' ImageCast Remote 5.2 Remote Accessible Vote by Mail System. OVSTA submitted the Electronic Poll Book regulations to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for final review on February 27, 2018. The regulation documents can be viewed on our website at: www.sos.ca.gov/administration/regulations/proposed-regulations/.

Governor Brown has proposed a one-time expenditure of \$134 million in California's 2018-2019 budget to replace voting systems for all of the state's 58 counties. The funding is to be provided as a one-time General Fund spending to purchase new hardware, software, and initial licensing to replace existing systems and technology. However, counties will be required to provide a dollar-for-dollar match to receive the state funding. The Senate budget hearing was held on Thursday, April 5, 2018. The Assembly budget hearing will be held on Tuesday, April 17, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in State Capitol, Room 447.

Counties desiring to implement a ballot on demand solution for the upcoming election are encouraged to submit their application to OVSTA as soon as possible so that OVSTA is able to timely review the application and documentation in advance of the election. OVSTA began certification testing of Hart InterCivic's Verity 3.0 Voting System on April 2, 2018. Certification testing is expected to continue through the coming months.

Administrative Approval Requests and Approvals

Runbeck Election Services submitted an administrative approval request for their Simulo Ballot Duplication system on March 12, 2018. The application and system documentation are currently under review and testing activities will be scheduled soon.

Democracy Live, Inc. submitted an administrative approval request for three modifications to their Secure Select 1.0 system. The modifications are as follows: remove focus management from inside the application, change the first page to be Ballot Marking instead of the Welcome page, and move interface language and translations to be part of the ballot definition file status. Testing of these modifications is expected to continue through April.

OVSTA finished testing of Dominion Voting Systems, Inc.'s Interscan HiPro 821D Hi Speed Scanner. Final reports will be forthcoming.

Dominion Democracy Suite DVS 5.5. The EAC approved Revision C of the Test Plan on February 1, 2018.

ES&S EVS 6.0.0.0. The EAC approved Revision 1.2 of the Test Plan on January 16, 2018.

ES&S EVS 5.4.1.0. The EAC approved the application for EVS 5.4.1.0 modification to include a new hardware version of the ExpressVote to the previously certified EVS 5.4.0.0 voting system On March 2, 2018.

Disposal or Sale of Equipment Purchased with Help America Vote Act (HAVA) and/or Voting Modernization Bond (VMB) Funding

In 2012, the California Secretary of State issued guidance regarding the disposition or sale of equipment purchased with HAVA and/or VMB funding. See [Secretary of State \(SOS\) County Clerk/Registrar of Voters \(CC/ROV\) Memorandum #12219 - Handling the Sale and Funds from the Sale of Voting Systems or Voting Equipment](#). The document outlines proper disposal or sale procedures of voting systems or voting equipment purchased with HAVA and/or VMB funding. The document also highlights that all equipment must be void of any software or firmware and returned to a condition of a non-functioning piece of hardware prior to its disposal or sale.

Also, the EAC issued [Election Assistance Commission \(EAC\) Funding Advisory Opinion FAO-08-007](#). The document outlines proper disposal or sale account procedures for original or replacement equipment acquired with HAVA funding.
