RE: General Election: State Voter Information Guide (VIG) Order Forms

Please provide the number of State Voter Information Guides (VIG) and Text of Proposed Laws (TOPL) your county will need for the upcoming November 3, 2020, General Election and any special shipping instructions you may have on the attached State Voter Information Guide Order Form and return it to me by July 17, 2020.

If your county will need VIGs delivered to multiple locations, please specify the special shipping instructions pertinent to each location and indicate whether you would like the guides shipped on cartons, pallets, cartons on pallets, or any combination of the three.

As you know, the Secretary of State (SOS) will mail directly to voters registered up to September 4, 2020 (E-60), and those voters registered between September 5, 2020, (E-59) and October 5, 2020 (E-29).

Counties are still responsible for mailing VIGs to all of their overseas, out-of-state, and confidential voters, as well as to any in the error files provided by the VoteCal Team.

Pursuant to Elections Code section 9094(b), three copies of the VIG shall be kept at every polling place while an election is in progress, so that they may be freely consulted by the voters. We also recommend providing VIGs in the languages required in your county pursuant to Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act. Please make sure you order plenty of voter information guides to supply all polling places and vote centers and to mail to voters registered after E-29 that request a copy of the VIG.

Please note there will be a separate TOPL for this election which will not be mailed to households. Copies of the TOPL will be available online and in print by request only, per Elections Code section 9086(f). There is a section of the order form that allows counties to request quantities of the separate TOPL to be provided to voters upon request, for county office use, and for polling places or vote centers. The SOS recommends that counties request enough TOPLs so that at least three copies are available at *each* polling place or vote center within the county.

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Once the information has been compiled, we will send you a copy of your completed order and shipping instructions, and you will have an opportunity to make any changes at that time.
