RE: Regulations: Second Modifications to Statewide Voter Registration System  
Regulations - 15 Day Notice

The Secretary of State has modified the text of the proposed Statewide Voter Registration System regulations.

**Written Comment Period: July 17 – August 3, 2020**

Any interested person, or their authorized representative, may submit written comments pertaining to the changes to the text of the regulations. The Secretary of State will accept written comments on the changes from July 17, 2020, to August 3, 2020. The Secretary of State will only consider comments received at the Secretary of State's office by that date.

Following the close of the written comment period, the Secretary of State, upon its own motion or at the instance of any interested party, may thereafter adopt the proposals provided by the public or may modify such proposals if such modifications are sufficiently related to the original text. With the exception of technical or grammatical changes, the full text of any modified proposal will be made available by our office for 15 days prior to its adoption and will be mailed to those persons who submit written comments related to this proposal or who have requested notification of any changes to the proposal.
