Re: 1% Manual Tally Report

To Whom It May Concern,

1% Manual Tally:

During the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election conducted in San Luis Obispo County, the 1% Manual Tally was completed on the poll and VBM ballots during the Official Canvass.

San Luis Obispo County operated 23 Voter Service Centers (VSCs) and one was randomly selected for the full ballot manual tally (two poll ballot batches). Two additional poll ballot batches were selected to manually tally the contests not contained in the batches for the selected VSC. For the VBM ballots, 744 batches of 200 ballots (148,800 total ballots) were counted at the time the random draw was performed on November 10, so eight batches were selected at random, with one additional batch selected for contests not covered by the initial eight batches.

During the manual tally, two differences were found. The first difference was the inadvertent removal of a YES vote on Proposition 15 during adjudication. The second difference was a system detected overvote on Proposition 24 which was allocated as a NO vote during adjudication, but the 1% tally board could not agree on voter intent.
