Re: March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election Manual Tally pursuant to California Election Code §15360

The 1% Manual Tally was advertised on www.amador.vote for 8 days and commenced at 9am on March 12, 2020. Precincts were drawn randomly at 3pm on March 11, 2020. Below are the precincts that were manual tallied (totaling 11% of ballots cast).

- CP12, consisting of 325 ballots, was drawn first and used to audit all Federal and State contests including President, US Representative District 4, Assembly District 5 and Proposition 13.
- CP1, consisting of 789 ballots, was drawn to audit Supervisor District 1.
- CP8, consisting of 160 ballots, was drawn to audit Supervisor District 2.
- CP20, consisting of 476 ballots, was drawn to audit Supervisor District 4.

Of all contests and ballots tallied, 1 discrepancy surfaced in the Supervisor District 1 contest. Review of the machine audit logs showed that this was due to operator error, and the discrepancy was rectified.
