

## Butte County 1 % Manual Hand Tally

California Elections Code Section 15360 states that: During the official canvass of every election in which a voting system is used, the official conducting the election shall conduct a public manual tally of the ballots tabulated by those devices in 1% of the batches chosen at random by the elections official. If 1% of the batches should be less than one batch, the tally shall be conducted in one batch chosen at random by the elections official. Additional batches for the manual tally may be selected at the discretion of the elections official.

The 1% manual hand tally performed in Butte County consists of a random draw of 1% of the batches in for Vote By Mail Ballots and 1% of the batches for Voter Assistance Center Ballots. This hand tally represents ballots cast on the ICX ballot marking devices, on paper at the Voter Assistance Centers, and vote by mail and all contests are counted. We also perform a random draw of 1% of the mailed ballot precincts and all races are counted.

In addition to the 1% hand tally, the elections official shall, for each contest not included in the initial group of precincts, count one additional precinct. The manual tally shall apply only to the contest not previously counted.
