REPORT OF THE MANUAL TALLY PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION MARCH 3, 2020

1% Manual Tally of Paper Ballots: The 1% manual tally is defined by Election Codes §336.5 as the public process of manually tallying votes in one percent of the batches, selected at random by the election official and in one batch for each race not included in the randomly selected batches. This procedure is conducted during the official canvass to verify the accuracy of the automated count. This tally includes paper ballots cast at the polling place or by mail.

On Thursday, March 5, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., the Department conducted a public random selection of precincts for the 1% manual tally. The Department randomly rolled six 10-sided dice for each digit of each batch number.

The following batches were randomly selected to cover 1% of all batches and to cover all contests:

- 302-056
- 507-013
- 304-076
- 505-021
- 407-001
- 406-017
- 504-011

Results of the 1% Manual Tally of paper ballots: During the 1% manual tally, the Department encountered no variances.

The results of the 1% manual tally confirmed the accuracy of the results from the ImageCast™ Central (ICC) paper ballot tabulating machines and Adjudication machines are accurate.
