To determine the precinct(s) to be manual tallied from the ballot cast in person at the Vote Center(s), precinct IDs were blind drawn from a lot containing identical containers with the IDs within.

To determine the batch(es) to be manual tallied from the vote-by-mail ballots, a coin was tossed to determine from which machine the batch will originate, heads will represent Machine A (Archie) and tails will represent Machine B (Barney). Then, to determine batch number, precinct IDs were blind drawn from a lot containing identical containers with the IDs within. The number of the precinct ID will represent the batch number. Since there is no precinct 24, precinct 1 will represent 24. Batches for this election are A8 thru A31, and B7 thru B30. To make it uniform, we drew from batch numbers 8 thru 30.
