Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

For the Recall Election, seven precincts were randomly selected to be manual tallied, as we always round up. Five 10 sided dice are rolled to select one digit of our five digit voting precinct numbers. If a digit does not exist, or the voting precinct has less than 200 voters, the dice is rolled again until a valid precinct is selected. Additional precincts were not selected to be hand counted this election as 1) there were no additional contests for this election and 2) all ballot tabulators had at least one precinct that contained a hand count. In addition to ballots tabulated on or before Election Day, one batch of tabulated ballots from each of the selected voting precincts that were tabulated the week after Election Day also had a manual hand count performed.

Voter Registration and Elections (VRE) will select the voting precincts to be included in the one percent manual tally for the September 14, 2021 California Gubernatorial Recall Election in accordance with [California Election Code 15360](#). Voting precincts will be selected at the Registrar of Voters office on September 15.

The manual tally process validates the tabulation of ballots generated by the electronic voting equipment before certifying election results. 7 of the 602 voting precincts for the Election will be selected. In addition, at least one batch from each ballot tabulator will be selected and included in the manual tally.
