One Percent Manual Tally: Discrepancy Detail

During the one percent manual tally three batches were determined to have one ballot in each batch that were missed in adjudication.

Batch 201-105 had one ballot that was voted in pencil where the voting target for Kermit Jones running for US Representative District 3 was too light for the tabulation system to detect it. This batch was then reprocessed through the adjudication system resulting in one additional vote for Kermit Jones and one less undervote.

Batch 202-139 had one ballot where the voter crossed out their vote for Alex Padilla running for US Senate (Full Term) while also filling in the voting target for Mark Meuser causing the system to read it as an overvote. This batch was reprocessed through the adjudication system removing the vote for Alex Padilla and leaving the vote for Mark Meuser resulting in the overvote count to decrease by one and one additional vote for Mark Meuser.

Batch 204-39 had one ballot where the voter crossed out their vote for Ray Nutting running for El Dorado High School District Governing Board Member. This contest has a vote for equal to three, although this ballot only had two candidates selected which caused the tabulation system to read it as an under voted contest, so it did not get sent to be adjudicated. To resolve this, the ballot was duplicated to reflect to single candidate selected by the voter which required the original batch (204-39) to be deleted, then the ballots were rescanned into a new batch (number 204-209). Once rescanned, the undervote total increased by one with Ray Nutting's total decreased by one.
