SAN FRANCISCO, Tuesday, September 27, 2022 – As it does before every Election Day, the Department of Elections invites representatives of the media as well as members of the public, the Civil Grand Jury, the League of Women Voters, and other interested organizations, to observe and provide input on various election processes in the November 8, 2022, Consolidated General Election.

"Ensuring transparency is a key aspect of maintaining election integrity," said Director John Arntz. "Members of the public are welcome to observe the Department's pre-election, Election Day, and post-election activities and provide their feedback. People may observe election processes in-person at the Department's office in City Hall and its warehouse on Pier 31, and can also observe remotely by viewing live-streams on the Department's website at sfelections.org/observe."

A complete calendar of observable activities for the November 8 Election is available at <u>sfelections.org/observe</u>. Some activities that may be of interest to the public include:

Date	Observable Election Activity
September 26 -October 14, 2022	Logic and Accuracy Testing. Logic and Accuracy testing of San Francisco's voting system is conducted prior to each election to ensure that the equipment properly records and accurately tabulates all votes.
October 11 - until no later than December 8, 2022	<u>Processing of Vote-By-Mail Ballots.</u> Vote-by-mail ballot processing includes sorting, scanning, and signature verification on ballot envelopes, opening of accepted ballot envelopes, and ballot extraction, in preparation for ballot counting.
October 14 - until no later than December 8, 2022	<u>Counting of Vote-by-Mail Mail Ballots.</u> Ballots extracted from accepted vote-by-mail ballot envelopes are scanned. The votes on the scanned ballots may not be tabulated or released until 8 p.m. on Election Night.
October 11- Election Day, November 8, 2022	City Hall Voting Center Opens. Starting October 11, any local voter, including certain non-citizen residents eligible to participate in the Board of Education Election, may register and/or vote at the City Hall Voting Center – open every weekday as well as the last two weekends before Election Day – or on Election Day, November 8.
October 28 - until no later than December 8, 2022	Adjudication of Vote-By-Mail Ballots. When ballots contain valid votes, including cases in which a ballot has been irregularly marked, torn, bent, or otherwise damaged and unreadable, the Department reviews and adjudicates these ballots.
Election Day, November 8, 2022	501 Polling Places are Open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day. Between 6 a.m. up through approximately 10 p.m., in-person voting set-up, processing, and closing activities will take place at the City Hall Voting Center and 501 polling places.
Election Night, November 8, 2022	Ballot Collection: After 8 p.m., the Department will receive voted ballots, rosters, and other vital materials from polling places at its Processing Center located on Pier 31; this process will continue until all polling place materials have been received.
Election Night, November 8, 2022	<u>Data Collection:</u> After 8 p.m., in City Hall the Department will receive the memory and results cartridges from polling places; this process will continue until all polling place memory devices have been received.
Election Night, November 8, 2022	Preliminary Results Reporting. At approximately 8:45 p.m. the Department will begin releasing preliminary election results at sfelections.org and in hard copy formats in City Hall, North Light Court. The Department will continue to process and count ballots after Election Day. At 4 p.m. every day on which the ballots are

Canvass Procedures: Random Selection of Precincts and Batches for the 1% Manual Tally

A. Materials used:

- 1. Precinct List: A list of the 501 precincts in San Francisco for which the Department of Elections (Department) organized polling places, in ascending order. The precinct list contains item numbers ranging from 001 to 501 that reference to individual precinct numbers.
- 2. Batch Lists: Lists of the batches of vote-by-mail and provisional ballots stored in assigned boxes. Vote-by-mail batches are assigned item numbers within ranges from 0001 2245. Provisional ballots are assigned item numbers within a range from 01 to 77.
- 3. Four Dice: Each die is 10-sided and numbered 0 to 9. The colors of the dice are red, white, blue, and yellow.
- 4. Lists that include the ballot content and ballot types for the election, and used to identify that the randomly selected polling place precincts and the selected batches of vote-by-mail and provisional ballots represent every contest voted upon during the election.

B. Explanation of the Process:

- 1. California Elections Code section (CAEC) 15360(a)(1)(A) requires a manual tally of ballots cast in 1% of the precincts and 1% of the vote-by-mail ballots cast. CAEC 15360 (a)(2)(II) allows for also tallying 1% of provisional ballots cast. The precinct and batch numbers must be selected randomly after the close of polls (CAEC 15360(d)). Since the November 8, 2022, Consolidated General Election is comprised of 501 polling places, the Department must randomly select a total of five precincts for which the Department will conduct a manual tally covering all contests. The Department will determine the number of batches of vote-by-mail and provisional ballots before the selections occur.
- 2. CAEC 15360(a)(1)(B)(i) requires the selection of additional precincts if not all contests voted upon were included in the initial group of precincts. The manual tally associated with these additional precincts will apply only to the contests absent from the precincts in the initial group of selections.
- 3. The selection of polling place precincts will require three dice (red, white, and blue) since there are 501 polling place precincts. The color of each die corresponds to its position in a 3-digit number combination. For instance, the red die will correspond to the first digit, the white die will correspond to the 2nd digit, and the blue die will correspond to the 3rd digit. As an example, the number "132", represents a roll of which the "1" appeared on the red die, the "3" on the white die, and the "2" on the blue die.
- 4. The selection of the batches of vote-by-mail ballots will utilize four dice since the Department processed 2,245 batches of vote-by-mail ballots. This extra die will be yellow. Obtaining numbers from each die will occur in the sequence as for the polling places precincts, (red, white, and then blue) and followed with adding the number showing on the yellow die.
- 5. The selection of provisional ballots will require two dice since Department processed 77 batches. The two dice for selecting provisional ballots for manual tally will comprise one red and one white die.
- 6. Department personnel will record the outcome of each rolling of dice and will review lists of item numbers to determine that the sufficient numbers of precincts and batches are selected.

C. Steps in the selecting of the precincts:

- 1. A member of the public or a Department representative will place the dice in one or both hands and then roll the dice onto a table.
- 2. The numbers facing up on each die will be announced by a Department representative according to the color of the dice. The number on the red die will be the first number announced, the number on the white die will be second number announced, and the last number announced will be that from the blue die.
- 3. For selecting batches of vote-by-mail ballots, the Department will add a fourth die which will be yellow.
- 4. For provisional ballots, the Department will roll one red and one white die since the batch numbers are two digits. The red die will represent the first numeral of the batch, and the white will represent the second numeral.
- 5. Department personnel will type the numbers as they are called and record them onto a screen located near the table on which the dice are rolled. The Department will stream a view of this monitor on its website.
- 6. If the number combination falls outside the ranges of precincts or batches, Department personnel will announce aloud that the dice represent a number combination that is outside the range of the sequentially listed precincts.
- 7. If the number combination falls within the range of precincts or batches, Department personnel will announce the corresponding precinct or batch number and record them onto the screen.
- 8. After the initial precincts, or the number of batches, have been selected, the Department will determine if all contests from the election are included in this first group of precincts or batches.
- 9. If there is a contest or contests not included in this initial group of precincts or batches, a Department representative will state which contest or contests require additional rolling of the dice. The Department representative will also state that, for these subsequent precincts or batches, only the contest not yet included in the selected precincts or batches requires a manual tally.
- 10. After the initial group of precincts or batches is determined, for all subsequent rolls of the dice, a Department representative will announce whether the numbers on the dice match a precinct or batch item number, and, if so, represent a precinct or batch from which contest or contests must be added to the manual tally.
- 11. When the additional precincts are identified, the Department will announce that the selection of precincts is completed.
- 12. The Department will post outside the door to its public entrance the list of precincts and batches and their relative contests that the Department will manually tally. The notice will include the time and location of the manual tallies. The Department will also livestream and also the selection process and will post the recording on its website.

D. Ballot Content

- 1. Every voter received a five-card ballot for this election.
 - a. Card 1: Voter-nominated offices of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Controller, State Treasurer, Attorney General, State Insurance Commissioner, Board of Equalization, United States Senator (Full Term), and United States Senator (Partial Term), United States Representative, Member of the State Assembly; nonpartisan offices for Chief Justice of the State Supreme Court, and three contests for Associate Justice of the State Supreme Court.
 - b. **Card 2:** Nonpartisan offices of Presiding Justice for the Court of Appeal, seven contests for Associate Justices for the State Court of Appeal, Board of Education, Bay Area Rapid Transit Director, Community College Board (Full Term), and Community College Board (Partial Term).
 - c. Card 3: Office of the Assessor-Recorder, District Attorney, and Public Defender.
 - d. Card 4: State Propositions 1, 26 31, and City and County propositions A C.
 - e. Card 5: City and County propositions D O.

November 8, 2022, Consolidated General Election Results of 1% Post-Election Manual Tallies

Pursuant to state elections law, the San Francisco Department of Elections (Department) is required to conduct a manual tally of all ballots cast in 1% of San Francisco's polling places and 1% of the vote-by-mail ballots cast, and may also manually tally 1% of provisional ballots cast, as part of the Official Canvass of the election. The Department compares the results of the manual tallies to the results reports generated by the voting equipment used to tabulate ballot cards. The purpose of the manual tallies is to verify the accuracy of the voting equipment used in the election. Upon completion of the 1% manual tallies, the Department prepares a report on the results of the manual tallies and includes the report in the certification of the Official Canvass for the election.

The following is a report on the results of the manual tallies of 1% of the polling places, vote-by-mail (VBM), and provisional ballots (PV) cast in the November 8, 2022, Consolidated General Election.

Random Selection of Precincts

On November 18, 2022, the Department conducted a random selection of precincts and batches to identify the ballots to include in the manual tallies in accordance with California Elections Code section 15360.

Five days prior to selecting the precincts and batches for the manual tallies, the Department issued a press release and posted a public notice on its website, *sfelections.org*, and outside its office, announcing the date, time, and place of the random selection of precincts and batches. Additionally, the Department webcast the random selection process and posted a recording of the random selection of ballots on its website.

For the November 8 election, the Department was required to conduct a manual tally of ballots cast in a minimum of five precincts, to represent 1% of San Francisco's 501 polling places included in the election, then 23 batches of VBM ballots to represent 1% of 2,245 batches of VBM ballots cast, and, finally, one PV batch to represent 1% of the 77 batches of PV ballots. State elections law also requires a manual tally of votes cast to be conducted on all contests present in the election.

The random selection was divided into three categories. The first category was for selecting five precincts for ballots cast at the polling places. The second category was for selecting 23 batches (or boxes) of VBM ballots. The third category was for selecting one batch (or box) for the Provisional (PV) ballots.
